

The trial produced 110,470 litres of milk for the Brisbane market in the first 110 days of grazing. The average quality of milk produced per cow was similar on all treatments (15 litres cow per day).

Costs of production (Table 1) were divided more or less equally between supplements (1.6 kg corn and cob meal plus sorghum hay daily) and forage production (pasture establishment, maintenance fertilizer, fencing, antilloat oil). The trial is expected to run until mid November (a further 5 weeks) in which time we anticipate an increase in the gross margin of returns over costs.
